

BE SAFETY RESPONSIBLE

- Preventing accidents is everyone's responsibility.
- Common safety sense and awareness of your surroundings is key to preventing accidents.
- If it looks unsafe, it probably is unsafe.
- Immediately report all unsafe conditions and eliminate the hazards.
- Inspect all tools and equipment before using. Never use damaged tools and equipment.
- Use the right tool and equipment for the job. Use the equipment or tool within their design limits.
- Follow all safety rules and practices.
- Don't rush a job or take short cuts.
- If you need help or are unsure about something, ask for help. Remember teamwork.
- Stay focused on the job- no horseplay.
- Participate, support and provide input in workplace safety.
- Report work related illnesses and injuries immediately to your supervisor.
