Inspect

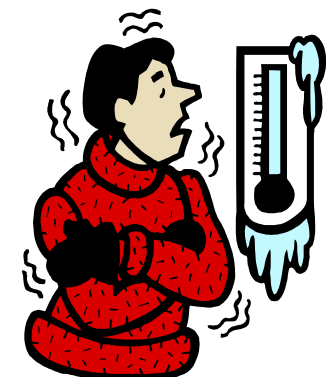
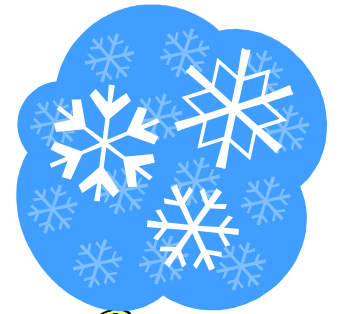
- Inspect areas on a routine basis for ice and snow hazards.

Control

- Remove ice and snow promptly.
- Apply salt or other de-icing materials.
- Provide covered salt container for employees to apply salt or other de-icing materials in parking areas and other walking areas.
- Place floor mats at inside entry points.
- Promptly clean up wet spots inside doorways from melting snow tracked inside.

Employees

- Wear rubber-soled shoes or boots with winter traction.
- Avoid rushing when walking in parking and other walking areas.
