- Use a brush or tool to apply the cement to stopping wall.
- Always read the material safety data sheet (MSDS) and familiarize yourself with safe work practices related to the material you are using.
- Avoid allowing the material to accumulate between your knee pads, shirt cuffs, gloves cuffs, and other similar areas.
